BASIC CURRICULUM GOALS (Partial list)

Bible	Memory verses, hymns & choruses, books of the Bible, main characters of the Bible; lessons such as Creation, Noah, Jonah, Good Samaritan, etc.
Math	Simple counting 1-50; number concepts 1-10.
Language Arts	Use phonics (phonograms) as the primary building blocks for teaching students to read. Language development and listening skills that include the Bible, color words, shapes, animals, transportation, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners, science. Recognition of name, sound, and picture for short vowels and consonants. Formation of vowels and consonants in upper and lower case.
Art	Gluing, scissors skills, painting and coloring in the lines. Contol.

BASIC CURRICULUM GOALS (Partial list)

Bible	Building onto the 3-year-old preschool, adding more memory verses, hymns & choruses, review books of the Bible, main characters of the Bible; addition of Bible lessons, such as the Birth of Christ, Boyhood of Jesus, Daniel, etc.
Math	Number recognition and counting 1-100; number concepts 1-20, numbers before and after 1-20; numbers largest and smallest 1-20; simple addition facts; patterns.
Language Arts	Use phonics (phonograms) as the primary building blocks for teaching students to read. Recognition of name, sound, and picture of long and short vowels and consonants; sounding of blends and one- and two-vowel words; reading of sentences and stories with one- and two-vowel words. Writing - formation of letters, blends, and words; writing of first name and last name. Poetry - Poems an dfinger plays committed to memory. Language - language development and listening skills that include the Bible, color words, shapes, animals, transportaion, countries, community helpers, health, safety, manners, science.
